PRODUCTION NOTES

The musical 9 to 5 opened on Broadway almost 30 years after the release of the classic cult movie of the same name. Dolly Parton was already a music sensation when the movie premiered, but the film catapulted her to cultural icon status-one that embodies both femininity and women's rights. She had appeared in movies in the past, but something was different about 9 to 5. It was more than a tale of three women who'd had enough of being disrespected and underpaid by a "sexist, egotistical, lying, hypocritical bigot." It was the story of three very different people accepting the opportunity to be agents of change. Together, they were fighting for fairness, creating a voice for the underrepresented, and striving to improve their environment with each new day. It was a story that through a healthy mix of reality, farce, and hyperbole motivated many.

43 years later, *9 to 5* remains an inspirational tale and one I think you'll enjoy. But I can't help but acknowledge that we're still living in a world with sexual harassment, inequality, and toxic work environments. I wish I didn't know this was true, but I do. I have wanted to work on 9 to 5 for so long, and bringing Dolly Parton's iconic and energetic music to life has been truly wonderful. But telling this story about empowerment and the need for community support with this immensely talented cast and production team has truly been the best reward.

Above all things, Dolly is a storyteller. Through song, musical, and film, we have witnessed this over and over again. As a director, I take my job as a story-builder and sharer seriously, and I hope that what we present today motivates you to consider your role as an agent of change. We all have the potential and responsibility to advocate for change and help transform through inspiration and influence. I hope this combination of toe-tapping goodness and honest portrayal of vulnerability stirs that passion within you.

Like the fictional world of Consolidated, Inc., this community and production would not shine without the many people of the Hershey Area Playhouse. Thank you to the Board of Directors, Committee Members, and Volunteers for their endless passion and dedication to our success. Each serves as an ambassador of the exceptional education and theatrical work that takes place here.

To this exceptional cast, thank you for bringing to life this energetic and important reminder of how we are agents of change. Mary, Jeff, Carlton, Miguel, Trent, and Matt, your talents in bringing this world to life is extraordinary. Every site, sound, and environment is created by you. Mohit, Sean, Megan, Molly, and Rosemary, thank you for being a true team of creators. I am so blessed to work with each of you. Kristin, thank you for every step and being with me for every step of life. And Kevin, thanks for always being my partner.
