

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Bandstand is not about what you think it is.

There have been many musicals based on this World War II period. Works such as Bernstein's *On the Town* or *Rodgers & Hammerstein's South Pacific* depict these times more as a musical valentine, focusing on either the comedic antics of three sailors let loose in NYC or a love story set against the backdrop of war. Both enjoyable, yes, but they are not created with much substance. But what if you took the grand feeling of a classical musical and added the realism of post-war America? You get *Bandstand*, a high-energy, swinging musical that showcases not only 1940s swing music, but also puts into the spotlight the real battles soldiers were going through at home.

As the opening of our story suggests, everyone thought that life would be "Just like it was Before," but in reality, these men were changed forever. Having seen and done things beyond imagination, they were fighting these mental battles alone, with most not having the strength to do so. The rawness of this show is that we see each soldier in the lowest moments, where everything is lost. That may sound really bleak. But there is hope in this show. It's music that pulls our characters out of the depths. One of my favorite lines from the show comes from "Breathe:" *I look to my left, I look to my right, and see other guys who fight the same fight, and during those few short hours a day, the noise in my head goes away.* We all may be fighting our own battles, but it is their recognition and the knowledge that we are not alone is what shows us the way forward and gives us hope.

This show could not be possible without the amazing group of collaborators behind me. You are all amazing storytellers and I thank you all for your talents and dedication to putting this together. Jasmine, thank you for standing beside and for fighting for what is right and real. Cause this is life and I wouldn't want anyone else here but you.
